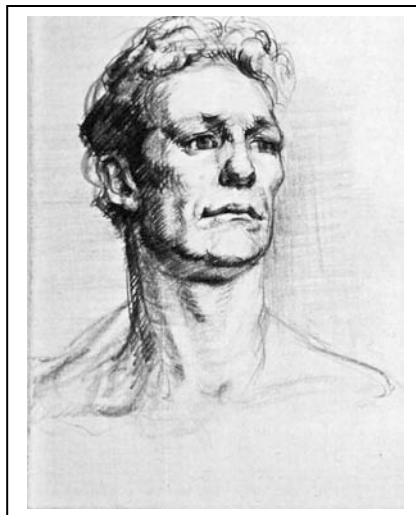
DYNAMIC FIGURE DRAWING
